Assembly theme this week

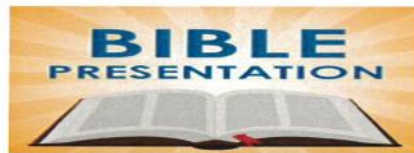
Our school value this half term and the theme for assemblies this half term is Service.
